



## Scholarship Application

The Scholarship Committee of Franklin First Federal Credit Union is pleased to offer scholarships for the 2023-2024 school year to eligible students.

Please note the following requirements and procedures:

1. Applicant, parent, or guardian must be a member in good standing of Franklin First Federal Credit Union.
2. Applicant must be a full-time student currently enrolled in or accepted to a college or university.
3. There will be no restriction on applicant's age or school in which he/she is currently enrolled.
4. Applicant will be judged on the following, with emphasis based on items in order as listed:
  - a) Financial need;
  - b) Transcript / GPA (through the end of first semester or second trimester);
  - c) School and community involvement in the past two years;
  - d) One full-page, typed, double-spaced essay on what you plan to choose for your major field of study, how it relates to your career goals and what financial need prompted you to apply for this scholarship.
5. Payment will be made directly to the applicant after the satisfactory completion of one semester of college. Proof of enrollment in 2nd semester is also required.
6. The Scholarship Committee will have the final decision regarding scholarship recipients.
7. Applications must be received by Friday, April 14, 2023. Scholarship recipients may be notified in writing by June 3, 2023 or may receive their scholarship award at school graduation ceremonies.

**Applications not completed in full will NOT be considered.**
